### Summary:

- **The majority of students (15) fall in the 30–50% bracket**, meaning they are just meeting the average expectation with learning levels aligned to **grade 3 and 4**.

- **A significant portion (13 students)** are in the **0–30% bracket**, highlighting a **large learning gap** from grade 3 and 4.
- **Only a small group (16 students)** (combining *Exceeds* and *Exceptional*) are performing **above average**.

Overall, the data shows that **most students are struggling at or just below the basic level**, with relatively fewer students demonstrating higher learning outcomes.

### **Recommendation (English):**

#### **Basic Foundation – Level 2**

- **Grade 1 concepts – 20%**
- **Grade 2 concepts – 40%**
- **Grade 3 concepts – 40%**

Since the majority of students are either **below average (0–30%)** or just **meeting the average expectation (30–50%)**, it shows that their **reading, writing, and comprehension skills are still rooted at primary levels (Grades 1–3)**.

By focusing on **20% revision of Grade 1 fundamentals (alphabets, phonics, sight words)**, then strengthening **Grade 2 skills (sentence formation, simple comprehension, vocabulary building)**, and finally giving more emphasis on **Grade 3 concepts (paragraph reading, grammar basics, guided writing)**, we can help students **bridge the foundational gaps**.

This structured approach will prepare them to **progress towards Grade 4 and 5 learning levels** with greater confidence, and eventually meet the academic expectations of **Grade 6**.

### Summary (Math):

- **The majority of students (29 students) fall in the 30–50% bracket**, which means they are just meeting the average expectation with learning from grade 3 and 4.
- **A very small portion (2 students) are in the 0–30% bracket**, showing **minimal learning gaps** compared to English.
- **13 students fall in the 51–80% bracket**, meaning they are **exceeding the expectation**.

Overall, the data shows that **most students are clustered around the average level**, with a stronger base in Math than in English.

### Recommendation (Math):

#### Focus on strengthening the Basic Foundation – Level 3

- **Grade 3 concepts – 20%**
- **Grade 4 concepts – 40%**
- **Grade 5 concepts – 40%**

From the Math result analysis, the **majority of students (29 out of 44) are in the 30–50% bracket**, which shows that they are at an average level and still need reinforcement of their basic concepts.

This distribution is designed to help students:

- **Revisit Grade 3 concepts (20%)** to fill smaller gaps and ensure no fundamental skills are missing.
- **Strengthen Grade 4 concepts (40%)**, as this is where many students begin to struggle with multi-step operations and problem-solving.
- **Build Grade 5 concepts (40%)**, so they can confidently transition into more advanced topics.

By focusing on this structured foundation, students will not only **consolidate their existing knowledge** but also be better prepared to **grasp Grade 6 concepts with clarity and confidence**.
